- Already this year, more than 200,000 children and youth have received God's Word through Bible League's *Project Philip* Bible studies and Bible-based Literacy classes.

Pray for Children and Youth

Week 2: In Malawi, young girls are often forced to marry early due to cultural beliefs practiced in the region. Recently, a 12-year-old girl was about to be married off. Thank the Lord for the teens who have completed Bible League's *Project Philip* Bible studies for youth in schools in four provinces in Burundi.

Please join in praying for the youth in Mara, Tanzania, as they graduate from *Project Philip* Bible studies. May they persist in their faith after the Bible studies so that they will not merely receive the books but remain strong in faith. May the Holy Spirit of God empower them to stand for evangelism everywhere they go. Pray for the program to continue to reach youth in different areas of the Mara Region.

Week 3: Thank God for the beginning of in-person Bible-based Literacy classes at a Hong Kong church's Vacation Bible School. Pray that God will use the literacy program to touch all the students' hearts. May God grant all the teachers the wisdom, strength, and heart to extend God's love to the children.

Pray for Pastor Lydia as she trains children's ministry leaders at her church in Miri, Malaysia. She has 90 sets of Bible-based Literacy and *Project Philip* Bible study materials ready for children. Pray that through these programs, God's Word will reach the next generation and beyond.

Thank the Lord for the kids and teens who heard the Gospel and completed *Project Philip* Bible studies through Pastor Marcus in Papua, Indonesia. Pray for Pastor Marcus and his wife as they faithfully teach the Good News to the children in their village of Kenari Ku-wawi.

Week 4: Let us pray for an after-school program that is happening in a Muslim-majority city where many Albanians live. Currently, the leader is using Bible League's *Project Philip* Bible studies for children in the program. Please pray for the children to believe in Jesus and become messengers of truth to their families.

In the sports stadium of Korçë, Albania, a local church is holding camps with the city's children. So far, 1,500 children have taken part and heard the Gospel through Bible League's resources. Thank God for these events. Pray for God's Word to touch the children's hearts and for them to share Christ with their families.
