Week 1

Please pray for those affected by recent flooding in **Burundi** that has wiped out everything in Gatumba, Kibenga, and Kajaga and forced people from their homes. Bible League primarily serves the country’s youth. At this time, they don’t know when they will return to their homes.

Pray for Marcos, Bible League’s ministry coordinator in southern **Brazil**, who is helping people left homeless by recent flooding in that region. Bible League’s

partner in Brazil recently provided blankets and water to people who lost homes and loved ones. Pray that many will find comfort and hope in God’s Word.

Brother Nrepen in **Bangladesh** asks for prayer as he leads small group Bible studies with college students. Ask the Holy Spirit to guide him as he tells the students about Jesus and prepares many of them to be disciples of Christ.

In May, students at Kwabenya Senior High School in **Ghana** began taking part in Bible League Bible studies. By God's grace, His Word will touch the lives of about 400 freshman and sophomore students, helping them to find new life in Jesus Christ. Thank God for the opportunity to use His Word to affect the lives of young people in that high school.

Week 2

Continue to pray for refugee families in **Armenia** who fled Nagorno-Karabakh (Artsakh). Some of them are now part of local churches and Bible study groups. Pray that the Lord will touch their hearts as they hear the Gospel. Pray, too, for Brother Arthur, a Bible League-trained church planter and trainer from Nagorno-Karabakh. After moving to Armenia, he started a small group Bible study for refugees that has now grown into a church in Yerevan, the capital. Thank God for this tremendous blessing! Ask the Lord to help this newly formed church grow in unity.

Please pray for Bible League-trained church planter Francisco in **Colombia**. Right now, violence and social crises are affecting the area where he is planting a new church.

Pray that the Gospel will bring peace to people across **Haiti**. Pray specifically for a Bible League trainer named Louis who is facing great challenges. Gang violence in his community is keeping him from training others to lead Bible studies.

The war between Israel and Hamas has many people in **Jordan** on edge. Jordan shares a nearly 400-mile border with Israel, putting it directly on the eastern front of the war. Pray that God will protect Christians in Jordan, providing them with safety and security as they practice their faith and share it with others.

Week 3

A new group of 44 church planters recently began their training in Guayas, **Ecuador**. Pray that God will bless each one as they follow the Lord's call on their lives.

Give thanks to God for the 18 indigenous church planters in Chittagong State in **Bangladesh** who will soon complete Bible League's Church Planting

Training. Pray that they will lead many in their communities to Jesus Christ.

Give thanks to God that His Church is growing around the world as the Holy Spirit works through Bible League's Scripture engagement programs. In **Zimbabwe**, more people are finding new life in Jesus Christ and local churches started earlier this year are expanding. In May, church leaders in Chiva baptized two new believers while leaders in Chitakai baptized eight people.

Praise the Lord for nine inmates in Bhimfedi prison in **Nepal** who received water baptism. Pray for their spiritual growth. Pray, too, for the four small groups in that prison who continue with the study.

After completing a Bible League Bible study in **Argentina**, 30 people committed their lives to the Lord through baptism. Praise God! Pray that they will remain steadfast, grow in faith, and multiply.

Praise God for Kahar, a pastor in Odisha, **India**, who is taking part in Bible League's Church Planter Training. After starting a new small group Bible study, he baptized three of the group members. Please pray for their spiritual growth in Christ.

Week 4

Praise the Lord that the Bible studies for adults, young people, and children in two places in **Madagascar**—Ambatomanoina and Bemasoandro—are going well. The children will soon finish the first book of Bible League's new *Discovery Basic* Bible study series. Pray that God's Word will make a lasting impact on the lives of all who are part of a Bible study, regardless of age.

Give glory to God for successful Bible study leader trainings recently held in **Malawi**. By God's grace, the more than 70 newly trained Bible study leaders will reach many more people with the Gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ.

Praise God! A new Bengali Bible-based Literacy group in northwest **Bangladesh** is now underway. Pray that the Hindu women who are part of the group will receive Jesus as they learn to read and write using God's Word.
